



OPC Covid-19 Re-Entry Policy

Updated: March 29, 2022

As our Covid-19 task force monitors the metrics of safe gatherings in and outside our building, we will continue to provide policy and procedures to ensure we keep our community safe. At this time, the following procedures will be required.

- If you have a temperature higher than 98.6, or have any other symptoms related to Covid-19 (cough, shortness of breath, runny nose, fever, loss of smell or taste, diarrhea), we ask that you stay home.
- For contact tracing and scheduling purposes, all usage of space must be coordinated ahead of time with the church office (office@opcbrookhaven.org).
- As long as Covid-19 community levels in DeKalb County, as tracked by the CDC, are in the LOW (green) or MEDIUM (yellow), wearing a mask indoors and outdoors will be highly encouraged, not required.
- If Covid-19 community levels in DeKalb County, as tracked by the CDC, rise to HIGH (red), we will return to requiring masks indoors for all.
- Use of outdoor space will be encouraged as much as possible, for classes, meetings, and other gatherings.
- Live-streaming of our worship services will continue, for those who wish to remain at home.
- Specific mask requirements may be made by church teams, with guidance from the covid-19 task force.

All individuals are expected to strictly follow these guidelines to preserve the safety and well-being of ourselves and others. It falls upon us to lovingly enforce these rules with one another for the sake of our community.

Vaccinations and the booster remain the most effective way to prevent the spread of covid-19 in our community, so we highly encourage all, who have not yet done so, to consider becoming fully vaccinated and boosted.

This document is subject to change. The OPC Covid-19 Task Force will continue to monitor the status of the virus over the following months to determine what next steps will be for our life together.
